Q: What content will be included in the magazine? Will it be the same content that was included in The Compass?

A: No, the magazine will share local feature stories, faith columns of families, marriage, youth & young adults, work-life balance, as well as a kid's page. In addition, the magazine will direct you to a diocesan calendar of events, career opportunities, and Mass schedules. Some content will be repurposed such as the kid's page, letter from the Bishop, frequently asked questions, etc.

Q: Will the magazine still include popular columns like Bishop Ricken, Fr. Girotti and Julianne Stanz?

A: Yes, however, the content of these columns will be geared to inspire people to a deeper relationship with Jesus.

Q: How are we supposed to get information about the Catholic Church? I do not have email and feel left out if I only get information 6 times per year.

A: In order to meet a variety of audiences, On Mission media has been designed to provide a bi-monthly magazine (print and digital), weekly e-newsletter and various posts in social media and on the website. Your parish bulletin and/or newsletter may provide further information regarding your parish community in print.

Q: Who will receive the magazine?

A: All households registered at a Catholic parish in the Diocese of Green Bay. If you do not receive the November/December print edition and you live in the 16 counties of the Diocese of Green Bay call 920-272-8208.

A: If you live outside the 16 counties of the Diocese of Green Bay and would like to subscribe to the print edition for \$20 per year, call 920-272-8208.

Q: Will there be advertising opportunities in the magazine?

Q: Our parish would like to provide copies of the print edition to visitors who attend Mass. Will bundles be available?

A: Yes, parishes can order bundles of the print edition for only \$4 per copy by calling 920-272-8208.
